Information for completing this form

The assessment for this component should be carried out according to the instructions and information given in the **Specification** and in the **Non-exam assessment Guidance** document for this component. A summary of the method is given below.

One form should be used for each candidate.

In carrying out assessments and recording outcomes centres should particularly bear in mind the following:

Length of folders

The recommended word count for this non examined assessment is **1500-2000 words for Task 1 and 1000-1200 words for Task 2**. Candidates should be encouraged to keep closely to this recommended word count. Footnotes, quotations and bibliographies are not included in the word count.

Candidates will not be specifically penalised for exceeding the word count; however, any response that significantly differs from the word count will be self-penalising either by not demonstrating the AOs to the required level or through lacking coherence and concision.

Teacher marks and comments

All folders must show evidence of assessment and should include **on the Cover Sheet**:

- The internally assessed **marks out of 24 for Task 1 and out of 16 for Task 2**.
- The total **mark out of 40 for the whole folder**.
- A **summative comment** that helps explain the final mark that has been given. This should be expressed in terms which relate to the level descriptors for this non examined assessment.

In addition, further annotation and comment in the body of the candidate's work is encouraged.

Summary of assessment method for this component

Mark **Task 1 out of 24 and Task 2 out of 16** by using the relevant set of non-examined assessment level descriptors given in the specification, as follows:

Task 1 is assessed for Assessment Objectives 1, 2, 3 and 4.

By using the 'best fit' principle, place the response within the appropriate level, considering the weighting given to each Assessment Objective, to determine the **mark out of 24**.

Task 2 is assessed for Assessment Objectives 2 and 5.

By using the 'best fit' principle, place the response within the appropriate level, considering the weighting given to each Assessment Objective, to determine the **mark out of 16**.

To arrive at a final mark out of 40, add together the marks for Task 1 and Task 2.
