## New resources to support you

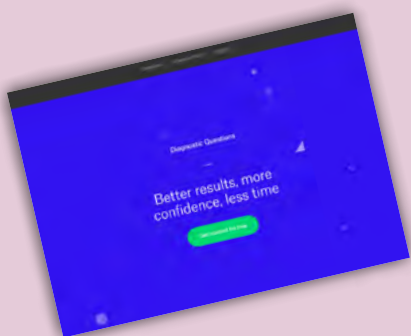
